The Palais de la Bourse of Bordeaux: Universal excellence

BORDEAUX PALAIS DE LA BOURSE - the only 2,700 m² conference centre located in the city centre - offers five ultra-modern event venues in a prestigious setting: an ideal place for meetings, discussions, presentations, and impressing your participants or clients. In 2010, the Palais de la Bourse, operated by the Bordeaux CCI, was fully renovated and modernised.

BORDEAUX PALAIS DE LA BOURSE with 2,700 m² of modular facilities in a unique historic and cultural setting, right in the centre of Bordeaux, is an ideal venue for all types of events. It is much in demand for its ideal location, on the banks of the Garonne River, near the Grand Théâtre opera house, several fine hotels, and a plethora of luxury boutiques.

Enhancing the attractiveness of Bordeaux for conference organisers

The four areas of the Palais de la Bourse are fully modular and equipped with state-of-the-art technology. Use all or any part of the space, to meet your specific needs: Espace Bourse (1,500 m²) is 100% modular, Espace Gabriel (250 m²) includes a 190-seat amphitheatre, Espace Garonne (260 m²) features reception rooms overlooking the Garonne River, and Espace Tourny (426 m²) has 7 elegant, interconnecting rooms, all superbly decorated and furnished in 19th-century style and Espace 1855 (285 m²) with a wonderful view on the embankment.

BORDEAUX PALAIS DE LA BOURSE offers a wide variety of equipment and services to meet all your requirements, thanks to a proactive technical and commercial team, always attentive to the client's needs, as well as carefully-selected suppliers and a fully-equipped catering area. All facilities are accessible to persons with reduced mobility.

Sustainable development at the heart of our approach

This venue, renovated in 2010 by the Bordeaux CCI, thanks to an investment of 7.7 million Euros, is environmentally-friendly, with an especially strong commitment to sustainable development. In particular, special attention is paid to waste management. For example, all plastic stoppers are collected to raise funds for an association and domestic waste is sorted by the staff into separate bins, including a special container for glass bottles.

Another feature of this venue is the systematic use of systems designed for mid- to long-term **water- and energy-savings**: LED lighting in the Hall de la Bourse, regular energy performance assessments, insulated windows from the construction stage, reuse in the water heating system, etc.

All our suppliers and service-providers are required to comply with these environmentally-friendly policies. BORDEAUX PALAIS DE LA BOURSE is also committed to reusing materials such as carpeting, fabrics, and structures installed for certain events.

UNESCO World Heritage

The building's history started in the 18th century, in 1731, when Jacques GABRIEL designed a royal palace that later became the Palais de la Bourse. Construction, which continued until 1749, was supervised by his son, Ange-Jacques Gabriel.

The statue of "Three Graces", which stands in the centre of the Place de la Bourse, was created by the French sculptor, Gumery, and monument-builder, Jouandot, in 1869.

Nowadays, the Place de la Bourse houses the Commercial Court and the Chamber of Commerce and Industry. The Place de la Bourse in Bordeaux is now considered one of the most successful examples of French city planning.

Location

A UNESCO World Heritage Site in the historic heart of Bordeaux, overlooking the Garonne River, close to the Place des Quinconces, one of the largest open squares in Europe, with direct access from the station and airport.

Contact - Access

Bordeaux Palais de la Bourse is located on line C of the tram system, with direct links to Saint Jean-station and the Place des Quinconces public transport interchange.

By air:

- ✎ Several flights daily to major European hubs
- ✎ Direct flights to the major European capitals
- ✎ Daily flights to all major French cities
- ✎ Regular shuttle connections from Bordeaux-Mérignac airport to Bordeaux city centre

By train:

- ✎ 10 minutes from Saint-Jean station by tram, line C
- ✎ TGV - high-speed trains: 20 trains per day to and from Paris

By car:

From the motorway and ring road:

- ✎ Take **exit 4**,
- ✎ Continue along Boulevard Aliénor d'Aquitaine,
- ✎ Turn left on Rue Lucien Faure,
- ✎ Turn right on Quai de Bacalan,
- ✎ Continue straight along Quai des Chartrons to Quai du Maréchal Lyautey,
- ✎ Turn right into Place de la Bourse.
